




Reading every day: the power of 1:1 reading



The expectation is that every child reads at home (or is read to by an adult) every day.

Where it is such a key life skill, we feel this sits at the very top of our home learning priorities.

Reading 'High 5'



- Bring your reading record in every day.
- An adult will check these weekly.
- Once you have read five times (this does not have to be in the same week and weekends can be included) an adult will tick the 'High 5' reading chart and you will be given a pom pom for our class jar!
- When the jar is full of pom poms, our class will get time to celebrate our success together with a reading raffle activity!









Home Learning: activities in addition to reading

Activity	Expectation
Daily Reading	5x 10min sessions a week
Doodle Maths	3x 10min sessions a week
Spellings [Year 2 only: from the Spring Term onwards]	Around 10 minutes a week via Spelling Shed
'Times Tables Rockstars' [Year 2 only: from the Spring Term onwards]	3x 10min sessions a week



Home Learning: activities in addition to reading



'Reach for the Stars' – optional enrichment activities to enjoy with your child:

- ⇒ Challenge 1: Create a shop at home and practise giving people a total for their shopping and change.
- ⇒ Challenge 2: Create a game of snap using the 2, 5 or 10 times tables.
- ⇒ Challenge 3: Colour in the 2, 5 and 10 times tables colouring sheet.
- ⇒ Challenge 4: Write a persuasive poster or letter to persuade an adult at home of something.
- ⇒ Challenge 5: Create an information report about an adult of your choice and their job.
- ⇒ Challenge 6: Write a fact file on a desert of your choice. You might choose Antarctica or the Sahara desserts that we are learning about at school.
- ⇒ Challenge 7: Create a self-portrait using shades of blue or red to show an emotion to link to our art topic of colour and tone.
