



### **Curriculum overview**


- **Literacy** Traditional tales; writing for different purposes such as a letter, postcard, birthday cards; writing own adventure story
- **Maths** Building numbers beyond 20; Counting patterns beyond 10; addition; subtraction; spatial reasoning
- **Topic** Our local area; landmarks; maps; buildings; houses and homes
- **PSED** Relationships roles; kindness; friendly behaviour; being a good friend;
- **EAD** collaging; junk modelling; sketches; combining watercolour and materials; wax resist; Paul Klee
- **R.E** Stories from different religions (Christianity; Hinduism; Islam; Sikhism)

# **Home Learning Expectations**

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## Reading every day: the power of 1:1 reading

The expectation is that every child reads at home (or is read to by an adult) every day.

Where it is such a key life skill, we feel this sits at the very top of our home learning priorities.

## Reading



- Record one entry per day (even if more books have been read)
- Book should be read **three times**;
- → first for blending
- → second for fluency
- → third for comprehension (asking questions to check for understanding)
- Reading records must be in school everyday
- Books will be changed on the day your child has read in school

### Reading 'High 5'

- Bring your reading record in every day.
- An adult will check these weekly.
- Once you have read five times (this does not have to be in the same week and weekends can be included) an adult will tick the 'High 5' reading chart and you will be given a pom pom for our class jar!
- When the jar is full of pom poms, our class will get time to celebrate our success together with a reading raffle activity!
